In the year 573 AD, two Mon brothers, Prince Samala and Prince Wimala, founded the Hongsavatoi Mon Kingdom at the present location of Pegu (Bago). King Samala became the first Mon King of Hongsavatoi Mon Kingdom. The Hongsavatoi Kingdom had flourished in peace and prosperity for many centuries.

Our Mon National Day usually falls on the first waning day of Maigh, the 11th month in the Mon lunar calendar. The Mon National Day commemorates which honours the founding of our glorious Hongsawatoi Mon Kingdom. The Mon has been celebrating Mon National Day since 1947. The first Mon National day was celebrated in Weitoot Village, Chaungzone Township, Mon State, Burma by Senior Ramanya Nikaya Mon Buddhist Monks as well as it was also celebrated in the same day by Nai Aung Tun, Chairman of Mon People Front Party in Pa-Nga and We-Kha-Ru villages, Than-Byu Za-Yat Township, Burma (Myanmar).

Since then, The Mon National Day celebrations are held in many places in Monland and around the world.
